**WARNING TO EVERYONE WHO HAS TESTED**  
**POSITIVE FOR COVID-19**

Residents of Jim Hogg County:

Any person who has tested positive for COVID-19, and has not subsequently tested negative, MUST isolate themselves from other people until they receive a negative result.

FAILURE TO DO SO may result in violation of TEXAS PENAL CODE 22.05 (a) to wit:

***“A person commits an offense if he recklessly engages in conduct that places another in imminent danger of serious bodily injury.”***

Please note that the victim does not have to get COVID-19 but just be exposed to it without previous warning.

Appearing in public after testing “Positive” EXCEPT for medical reasons to get medical care, can lead to a fine and possible confinement.

VICTIMS of this type of exposure may contact any Jim Hogg County Law Enforcement Officer or the Jim Hogg County Attorney’s Office.
