

Notice of Tax Rates

This notice concerns the 2021 property tax rates for Jim Hogg County. This notice provides information about two tax rates used in adopting the current tax year's tax rate. The no-new-revenue tax rate would impose the same amount of taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. In most cases, the voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

Indigent Defense Compensation Expenditures

The Jim Hogg County spent \$14,800 from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 to provide appointed counsel for indigent individuals, less the amount of state grants received by the county. In the preceding year, the county spent \$8,800 for indigent defense compensation expenditures. The amount of increase above last year's indigent defense expenditures is \$6,000. This increased the voter-approval rate by 0.000132/\$100 to recoup 5% more than the preceding year's expenditures.
