Order of the County Judge

No Outside Vendors


Pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, no outside vendors will be allowed in Jim Hogg County to set up and sell items until further notice. This includes vendors from out of town that visit our community to sell flowers, fruits, vegetables, plants, hay bales, food, etc. Vendors who have already set up have to leave by tomorrow, March 28, 2020 by 12:00 Noon.


The intent of this Order is to protect the physical health and well-being of Jim Hogg County citizens and to slow the spread of COVID-19 to the maximum extent possible while safeguarding the Constitutional liberties of Jim Hogg County citizens by utilizing common restrictive measures and encouraging the highest level of personal responsibility. This order is a proactive measure being taken for the health and safety of the citizens of Jim Hogg County, Texas. If you have any questions or need further guidance regarding this order, you may contact the Jim Hogg County Sheriff's Department at 361-527-3710.

A person who violates this order is subject to a fine up to \$500.00 (Class C Misdemeanor).

As County Judge, I hereby deem it necessary and so order that the curfew is hereby ordered until further notice or is rescinded.
