Order of the County Judge

ESTABLISHING CURFEW

UPDATED: 6/22/2020

Pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, a **curfew** is hereby established for all areas of Jim Hogg County Texas from **11:00 PM until 5:00 AM SUNDAY thru THURSDAY and 12:00 MIDNIGHT until 5:00AM on FRIDAY and SATURDAY to go into effect on Monday, June 22, 2020.** All individuals shall remain in or on personal property and avoid traveling on any public road or highway during this period of curfew. Individuals who are traveling to or from a place of employment or are assisting with emergency operations at the request of County Sheriff or Emergency Management Coordinator are exempt from the requirement of this order. Individuals traveling through Jim Hogg County, Texas due to an emergency necessity are exempt from the requirements of this order. This order does not apply to health care providers or to a licensed food company providing food and other consumables to others. Individuals who work for a company categorized as "essential" by the CDC are also exempt. These individuals should carry a letter from employers showing proof that they are part of the "essential" workforce. This order does not prohibit any person from leaving his or her home to seek necessary medical or emergency care.

The intent of this Order is to protect the physical health and well-being of Jim Hogg County citizens and to slow the spread of COVID-19 to the maximum extent possible while safeguarding the Constitutional liberties of Jim Hogg County citizens by utilizing common restrictive measures and encouraging the highest level of personal responsibility. This curfew is a proactive measure being taken for the health and safety of the citizens of Jim Hogg County, Texas. A person who violates this order is subject to a fine up to \$500.00 (Class C Misdemeanor).

As County Judge, I hereby deem it necessary and so order that the curfew is hereby ordered for the next 14 days.
